09YM6 - DRAWING THE LINE - Tim Manos

09YM16 - POP ART PARTY - Heather Wiechert

Art is fun – why not celebrate it? This class commemorates artwork by some of the most famous Pop Artists – and ends with an art-themed PARTY!!! Make Warhol wigs to wear, entertain with large dancing dog cut-outs, and build oversized food to share. What a pARTY this will be!

In this class, you will take ordinary, everyday objects and turn them into amazing sculptural works of art. This class is just the prescription the art doctor ordered for a case of Sculpture-Itis!

Paint like the modern masters! Begin this masterful journey with the impressionist style of Monet, set up your easel next to Van Gogh, find a new dimension of painting in the studio of Picasso and more. Brush up on your painting with no homework required!

09YM23 - SCULPTURE, PAINTING AND MORE - Tim Manos

09YM24 - RATATOUILLE'S KITCHEN - Paula Martinez

Food will be the focus of art projects in this class. Imagine creating art inspired by pizza, ice cream, sweets, burgers, fries, salads, spaghetti, and more! A variety of media will be used to create 2 and 3 dimensional work. This is just the class to wet your artistic appetite!

09YM30 - THAT'S THE REAL ME! - Marleejean Johnson

Realistic self portraits can be so *hard*! This time, let's try portraits with a twist! We will venture beyond real life portrait to *real* portraits of you! We begin with facial features and proportions and move on to a Byzantine diptych with self portraits in metal foil and words. The multiple views of Picasso's cubism are explored and then foreshortening will complete this series in portraiture.

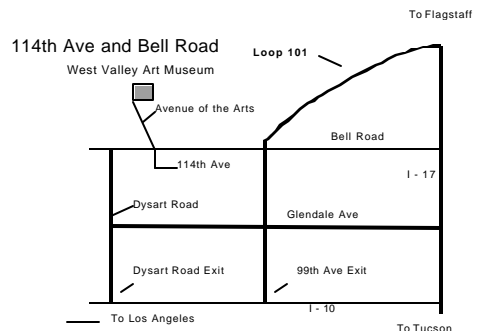
Refunds and Cancellations:
